## Service of Communion



### Invitation

- One: Come and taste the grace eternal,  
come and see that God is good.
- Many: We come to this table with faith that we will be fed  
by the spirit of Christ as we share the bread and cup.**
- One: Jesus said: "I am the bread of life.  
All who come to me will not be hungry;  
all who believe in me will never be thirsty."
- Many: We are hungry and thirsty.  
O Lamb of God, we come!**
- One: We remember that on the night of betrayal and desertion,  
Jesus took bread, and after he gave thanks to God,  
he broke the bread and gave it to his disciples saying:
- Many: "This is my body which is given for you.  
Do this in remembrance of me."**
- One: In the same way, Jesus also took the cup.  
After he gave thanks, he gave it to them, saying,  
"Drink of it all of you."
- Many: "This is the cup of the new covenant poured out  
for you and for many for the forgiveness of sins.  
Do this, as often as you drink it,  
in remembrance of me."**
- One: Holy Resurrected One, you have met us in our lives,  
let us now meet you at this table.  
Pour out your Spirit upon us and upon these your gifts  
of bread and cup, that they may be Christ broken and  
poured out for us. As we eat and drink, may we be filled

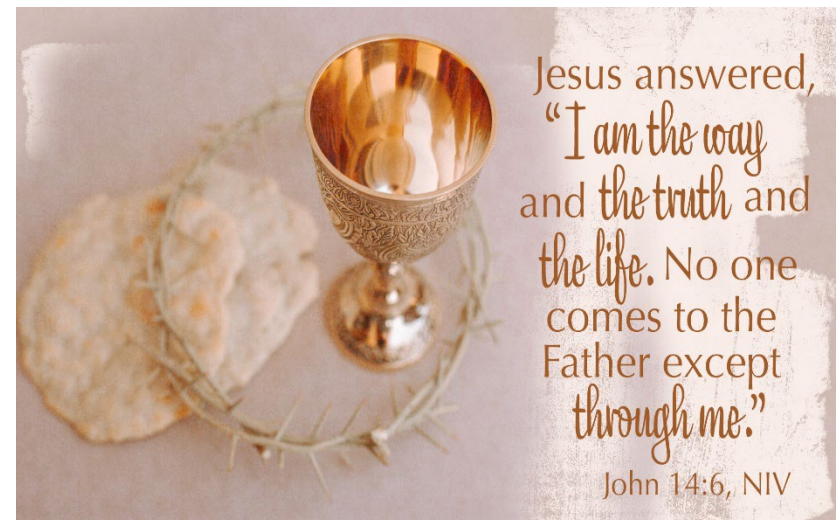
