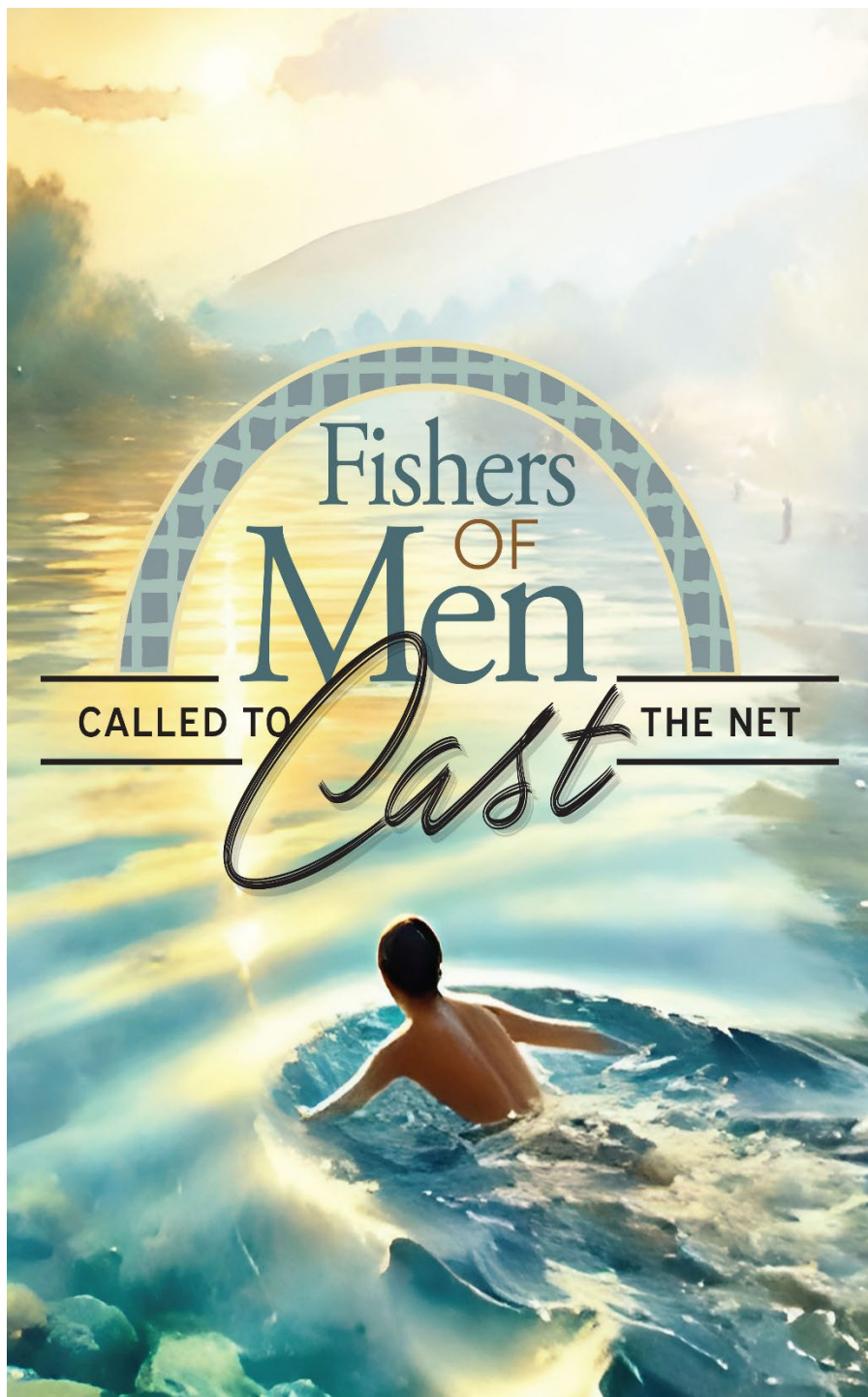
Cong Response SL #785 *God Be With You*
